Board of Directors Meeting August 18, 2020

Meeting called to order at 4:35 p.m. by President Stein Ericsson via zoom.

A financial report was given by Stein. All expenditures and income seem to be in line for the months of June and July YTD for 2020. Total cash in operating account as of 07/31/20 is \$52,909.06. Total cash in reserve account is \$182,951.69. Dustin will send invoices for Signature Gates and for Daryl Guess to Stein for work done in July. Stein motioned to approve the June/July 2020 financials. Catherine seconded the motion. Motion carried 5:0.

## Committee Report:

No outstanding requests

General discussion about tree trimming and dead trees from the heat in front yards. Also, discussion about promoting the need for owners to serve on the ARCH Committee.

## Ongoing Business:

- Landscaping: Payment on the irrigation work was approved for the work that was completed.
- Front Entrance: Jeff (Tenant Landscaping) proposed around \$900.00 for some plantings around the fountain. Colette agreed to do a little more research on some of the vegetation Jeff proposed. Permanent vegetation does seem to be the suggested method. Colete motioned up to 1000.00 for the project. Stein seconded the motion and the motion passed 5:0. This will be done in the Fall once the decision on what to plant is determined.
- Seal Coat: Rick reported that the meeting in June with Jesse (from Ace Asphalt), Dustin
  and Kandy was positive meeting. Jesse explained the product and the condition of the
  streets. It appears that the seal coat was successful, and the visible cracks are normal
  and expected.

## New business:

• 2021 Budget: After some discussion, it was determined that at this point, there is no need to increase fees in 2021.
